

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS Traverse experts

Definitions

1. Traverse experts: Traverse experts, established in Leerdam, Chamber of Commerce no. 30245077.
2. Customer: the person with whom Traverse experts has entered into an agreement.
3. Parties: Traverse experts and customer together.
4. Consumer: a customer who is an individual acting for private purposes.

Applicability

1. These terms and conditions will apply to all quotations, offers, activities, orders, agreements and deliveries of services or products by or on behalf of Traverse experts.
2. Parties can only deviate from these conditions if they have explicitly agreed upon in writing.
3. The parties expressly exclude the applicability of supplementary and/or deviating general terms and conditions of the customer or of third parties.

Offers and quotations

1. Offers and quotations from Traverse experts are without engagement, unless expressly stated otherwise.
2. An offer or quotation is valid for a maximum period of 3 months from its date, unless another acceptance period is stated in the offer or quotation.
3. If the customer does not accept an offer or quotation within the applicable time frame, the offer or quotation will lapse.
4. Offers and quotations do not apply to repeated orders, unless the parties have agreed upon this explicitly and in writing.

Acceptance

1. Upon acceptance of a quotation or offer without engagement, Traverse experts reserves the right to withdraw the quotation or offer within 3 days after receipt of the acceptance, without any obligations towards the customer.
2. Verbal acceptance of the customer only commits Traverse experts after the customer has confirmed this in writing (or electronically).

Prices

1. All prices used by Traverse experts are in euros, are exclusive of VAT and exclusive of any other costs such as administration costs, levies and travel-, shipping- or transport expenses, unless expressly stated otherwise or agreed otherwise.
2. Traverse experts is entitled to adjust all prices for its products or services, shown in its shop, on its website or otherwise, at any time.
3. Parties may agree on a no-cure no-pay base payment. Conditions of payment and fees will be agreed upon on in the underlying contract.

Consequences of late payment

1. If the customer does not pay within the agreed term, Traverse experts is entitled to charge an interest of 1% per month from the day the customer is in default, whereby a part of a month is counted for a whole month.
2. When the customer is in default, he is also due to extrajudicial collection costs and may be obliged to pay any compensation to Traverse experts.
3. The collection costs are calculated on the basis of the Reimbursement for extrajudicial collection costs.
4. If the customer does not pay on time, Traverse experts may suspend its obligations until the customer has met his payment obligation.
5. In the event of liquidation, bankruptcy, attachment or suspension of payment on behalf of the customer, the claims of Traverse experts on the customer are immediately due and payable.
6. If the customer refuses to cooperate with the performance of the agreement by Traverse experts, he is still obliged to pay the agreed price to Traverse experts.

Suspension of obligations by the customer

The customer waives the right to suspend the fulfillment of any obligation arising from this agreement.

Settlement

The customer waives his right to settle any debt to Traverse experts with any claim on Traverse experts.

Delivery period

1. Any delivery period specified by Traverse experts is indicative and does not give the customer the right to dissolution or compensation if this period is not met with, unless the parties have expressly agreed otherwise in writing.
2. The delivery period starts after the customer has signed the agreement to Traverse experts and is confirmed in writing or electronically by Traverse experts to the customer.
3. Exceeding the specified delivery period does not entitle the customer to compensation or the right to terminate the contract, unless Traverse experts cannot deliver within [number of days late] or if the parties have agreed upon otherwise.

Actual delivery

The customer must ensure that the actual delivery of the products ordered by him can take place in time.

Transport costs

Transport costs are on behalf of the customer, unless the parties have agreed upon otherwise.

Packaging and shipping

1. If the package of a delivered product is opened or damaged, the customer must have a note drawn up by the forwarder or delivery person before receiving the product. In the absence of which Traverse experts may not be held liable for any damage.

2. If the customer himself takes care of the transport of a product, he must report any visible damage to products or the packaging prior to the transport to Traverse experts, failing which Traverse experts cannot be held liable for any damage.

Insurance

1. The customer undertakes to insure and keep insured the following items adequately against fire, explosion and water damage as well as theft:
 - o goods delivered that are necessary for the execution of the underlying agreement
 - o goods being property of Traverse experts that are present at the premises of the customer
 - o goods that have been delivered under retention of title
2. At the first request of Traverse experts, the customer provides the policy for these insurances for inspection.

Guarantee

When parties have entered into an agreement with services included, these services only contain best-effort obligations for Traverse experts, not obligations of results.

Performance of the agreement

1. Traverse experts executes the agreement to the best of its knowledge and ability and in accordance with the requirements of good workmanship.
2. Traverse experts has the right to have the agreed services (partially) performed by third parties.
3. The execution of the agreement takes place in mutual consultation and after written agreement and payment of the possibly agreed advance by the customer.
4. It is the responsibility of the customer that Traverse experts can start the implementation of the agreement on time.
5. If the customer has not ensured that Traverse experts can start the implementation of the agreement in time, the resulting additional costs and/or extra hours will be charged to the customer.

Duty to inform by the customer

1. The customer shall make available to Traverse experts all information, data and documents relevant to the correct execution of the agreement to in time and in the desired format and manner.
2. The customer guarantees the correctness, completeness and reliability of the information, data and documents made available, even if they originate from third parties, unless otherwise ensuing from the nature of the agreement.
3. If and insofar as the customer requests this, Traverse experts will return the relevant documents.
4. If the customer does not timely and properly provides the information, data or documents reasonably required by Traverse experts and the execution of the agreement is delayed because of this, the resulting additional costs and extra hours will be charged to the customer.

Duration of the agreement

1. The agreement between Traverse experts and the customer is entered into for the duration of 10 months, unless it results otherwise from the nature of the agreement or if the parties have expressly agreed otherwise in writing.

2. If a fixed-term contract has been entered into, it will be tacitly converted into an open-ended contract at the end of the term, unless 1 of the parties terminates the contract with due observance of a notice period of 2 month(s), or if a consumer terminates the agreement with due observance of a notice period of 1 month / the agreement ends at the end of the fixed term.
3. If the parties have agreed upon a term for the completion of certain activities, this is never a strict deadline, unless specified explicitly otherwise in writing. If this term is exceeded, the customer must give Traverse experts a written reasonable term to terminate the activities, before it may either terminate the contract or claim damages.

Confidentiality

1. The client keeps any information he receives (in whatever form) from Traverse experts confidential.
2. The same applies to all other information concerning Traverse experts of which he knows or can reasonably suspect that it is secret or confidential, or of which it can expect that its disclosure may cause damage to Traverse experts.
3. The customer takes all necessary measures to ensure that he keeps the information referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 secret.
4. The obligation of secrecy described in this article does not apply to information:
 - o which was already made public before the customer heard this information or which later became public without being the result of a violation of the customer's duty to confidentiality
 - o which is made public by the customer due to a legal obligation
5. The confidentiality obligation described in this article applies for the duration of the underlying agreement and for a period of 3 years after the end thereof.

Penalties

1. If the customer violates the articles of these general terms and conditions about secrecy or intellectual property, then he forfeits on behalf of Traverse experts an immediately due and payable fine of € 5.000 1.000 for each violation and in addition an amount of 5% of the aforementioned amount for each day that this violation continues.
2. No actual damage, prior notice of default or legal proceedings are required in forfeiting the fine referred to in the first paragraph of this article.
3. The forfeiture of the fine referred to in the first paragraph of this article shall not affect the other rights of Traverse experts including its right to claim compensation in addition to the fine.

Indemnity

The customer indemnifies Traverse experts against all third-party claims that are related to the products and/or services supplied by Traverse experts.

Complaints

1. The customer must examine a product or service provided by Traverse experts as soon as possible for possible shortcomings.
2. If a delivered product or service does not comply with what the customer could reasonably expect from the agreement, the customer must inform Traverse experts of this as soon as possible, but in any case within 1 month after the discovery of the shortcomings.
3. Consumers must inform Traverse experts of this within two months after detection of the shortcomings.
4. The customer gives a detailed description as possible of the shortcomings, so that Traverse experts is able to respond adequately.

5. The customer must demonstrate that the complaint relates to an agreement between the parties.
6. If a complaint relates to ongoing work, this can in any case not lead to Traverse experts being forced to perform other work than has been agreed.

Giving notice

1. The customer must provide any notice of default to Traverse experts in writing.
2. It is the responsibility of the customer that a notice of default actually reaches Traverse experts (in time).

Joint and several Client liabilities

If Traverse experts enters into an agreement with several customers, each of them shall be jointly and severally liable for the full amounts due to Traverse experts under that agreement.

Liability of Traverse experts

1. Traverse experts is only liable for any damage the customer suffers if and insofar as this damage is caused by intent or gross negligence.
2. If Traverse experts is liable for any damage, it is only liable for direct damages that results from or is related to the execution of an agreement.
3. Traverse experts is never liable for indirect damages, such as consequential loss, lost profit, lost savings or damage to third parties.
4. If Traverse experts is liable, its liability is limited to the amount paid by a closed (professional) liability insurance and in the absence of (full) payment by an insurance company of the damages the amount of the liability is limited to the (part of the) invoice to which the liability relates.
5. All images, photos, colors, drawings, descriptions on the website or in a catalog are only indicative and are only approximate and can not lead to any compensation and/or (partial) dissolution of the agreement and/or suspension of any obligation.

Expiry period

Every right of the customer to compensation from Traverse experts shall, in any case, expire within 12 months after the event from which the liability arises directly or indirectly. This does not exclude the provisions in article 6:89 of the Dutch Civil Code.

Dissolution

1. The customer has the right to dissolve the agreement if Traverse experts imputably fails in the fulfillment of his obligations, unless this shortcoming does not justify termination due to its special nature or because it is of minor significance.
2. If the fulfillment of the obligations by Traverse experts is not permanent or temporarily impossible, dissolution can only take place after Traverse experts is in default.
3. Traverse experts has the right to dissolve the agreement with the customer, if the customer does not fully or timely fulfill his obligations under the agreement, or if circumstances give Traverse experts good grounds to fear that the customer will not be able to fulfill his obligations properly.

Force majeure

1. In addition to the provisions of article 6:75 Dutch Civil Code, a shortcoming of Traverse experts in the fulfillment of any obligation to the customer cannot be attributed to Traverse experts in any situation independent of the will of Traverse experts, when the fulfillment of its obligations towards the customer is prevented in whole or in part or when the fulfillment of its obligations cannot reasonably be required from Traverse experts .
2. The force majeure situation referred to in paragraph 1 is also applicable - but not limited to: state of emergency (such as civil war, insurrection, riots, natural disasters, etc.); defaults and force majeure of suppliers, deliverymen or other third parties; unexpected disturbances of power, electricity, internet, computer or telecoms; computer viruses, strikes, government measures, unforeseen transport problems, bad weather conditions and work stoppages.
3. If a situation of force majeure arises as a result of which Traverse experts cannot fulfill one or more obligations towards the customer, these obligations will be suspended until Traverse experts can comply with it.
4. From the moment that a force majeure situation has lasted at least 30 calendar days, both parties may dissolve the agreement in writing in whole or in part.
5. Traverse experts does not owe any (damage) compensation in a situation of force majeure, even if it has obtained any advantages as a result of the force majeure situation.

Modification of the agreement

If, after the conclusion of the agreement and before its implementation, it appears necessary to change or supplement its contents, the parties shall timely and in mutual consultation adjust the agreement accordingly.

Changes in the general terms and conditions

1. Traverse experts is entitled to amend or supplement these general terms and conditions.
2. Changes of minor importance can be made at any time.
3. Major changes in content will be discussed by Traverse experts with the customer in advance as much as possible.
4. Consumers are entitled to cancel the agreement in the event of a substantial change to the general terms and conditions.

Transfer of rights

1. The customer can not transfer its rights deferring from an agreement with Traverse experts to third parties without the prior written consent of Traverse experts .
2. This provision applies as a clause with a property law effect as referred to in Section 3:83 (2) Dutch Civil Code.

Consequences of nullity or annulability

1. If one or more provisions of these general terms and conditions prove null or annulable, this will not affect the other provisions of these terms and conditions.
2. A provision that is null or annulable shall, in that case, be replaced by a provision that comes closest to what Traverse experts had in mind when drafting the conditions on that issue.

Applicable law and competent court

1. Dutch law is exclusively applicable to all agreements between the parties.
2. The Dutch court in the district where Traverse experts is established is exclusively competent in case of any disputes between parties, unless the law prescribes otherwise.
